Parish Expenses ~ A Wide Diversity

In any particular week there are a variety of invoices that need to be paid for the operations of the parish. Utility costs like electricity and gas are rather obvious. And many parishioners would be already aware that all the parishes have to pay 10% of their planned giving income and "second collection loose" to the Diocese. There's also insurance for all the parish buildings. And we're now about to purchase a new photocopier for a little over \$10,000.

Sometimes there are other comparatively smaller costs that mightn't be so obvious. An account of almost \$1,200 has just been paid for permission from licensing agents to display the words of hymns on the overheads at Mass. This is fair enough as composers, musicians and publishers should be properly remunerated for the use of their music. That's social justice.

But just as items like incense, candles, altar breads, altar wine, auditor's fees may be comparatively minor, they still all add up. So thanks to all our parishioners for your continued financial support. The auditing of the parish finances should be completed before the end of the month.
