Indeed, the programme has its greatest benefit when sacrifice is embraced by parents and children. This will become clearer as the programme unfolds. During the interim, it's a good idea for parents and children to talk about how they can all make sacrifices.





EUCHARISTIC ADORATION: Have you ever made an offering to the Blessed Sacrament in the Votive Candle Stand near the Tabernacle? A little offering is an expression of gratitude to the wonderful ways in which our lives have been blessed and sanctified by the grace of this most holy sacrament. And having made the offering, we are then encouraged to spend a few moments in personal prayer.

Also, the proceeds from the votive candle stand are eventually directed towards the acquisition of other liturgical items. A little over a month ago, a monstrance was purchased for St Clare's. The older monstrance required the host – before

consecration – to be trimmed to fit into the lunette. And the older monstrance was also noticeably discoloured. Accordingly, the monstrance pictured above was purchased to replace the older one.

Eucharistic adoration takes place at St Paul's from 8:30 AM until 9:00 AM, Wednesday to Saturday. For those who like an earlier start, Eucharistic Adoration is available at St Clare's on Wednesdays, 7:30 AM to 8:00 AM.
