Sunday 5:00 PM ⇒ 4:00 PM F.H.C. Mass

In keeping with the practice of the past few years, on Sunday 26 November the normal 5:00 PM Mass will be moved an hour earlier to 4:00 PM to better provide for our parishioners who have children celebrating FHC.

In previous years about a dozen families have chosen the Sunday evening Mass for their children to celebrate FHC because it's their normal Mass of attendance. The earlier time is obviously more convenient for out-of-town visitors who after a little FHC gathering, may need to drive home over a substantial distance for work the next day.

Our regular parishioners are requested to attend this Mass to provide prayerful support. Because of the smaller numbers, this FHC Mass is generally only about 10 minutes longer than the normal 5:00 PM Mass.
