Handel's Messiah ~ 23 December

On Sunday 23 December at 7:00 PM, there will be a performance of Handel's Messiah in concert. The evening will begin at 7:00 PM with various formalities and local acts, estimated to be about 45 minutes. There will then be a 15 minute break to allow time to place chairs on the sanctuary for a choir and orchestra, comprising about 50 people. Handel's Messiah is about 90 minutes, allowing the night to come to conclusion at about 9:30 PM.

The church is expected to be quite full, and it will only be possible for people to enter with tickets, costing just \$15 each. There will be many other visitors from outside the parish. There may also be a few dignitaries in attendance, and James Arblaster has advised that he will be bringing around 15 of his mates from the seminary.



Men's Movie and Pizza Night



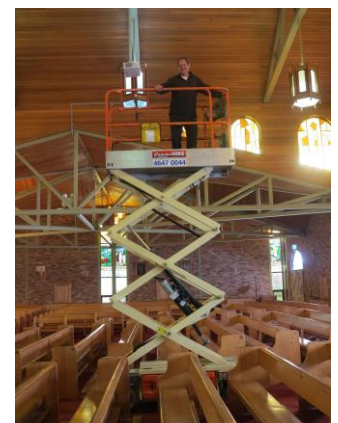
