

Catholic Mission ~ Healing a Nation through Education

This is the theme for this year's Catholic Missions Appeal which highlights the important work being undertaken in Myanmar through programs aimed to improve education for children. Funds from Catholic Mission are directed to teacher training and the implementation of alternative child centred education throughout the country.

These programs train aspiring teachers so they can bring modern education to areas in need. Prospective trainee teachers can be either scouted or nominated by their parish priest to benefit from being included in this training and include catechists, lay people and even religious sisters and novices. They receive four years of training which includes two years of practical teaching in the school environment to ensure quality education care for the children. Parishioners are encouraged to support with the customary generosity.
