St Paul's School Playground ~ Further Upgrade



The upper part of the playground adjoining John Street is soon to be upgraded. The existing bitumen cover is uneven in many places, especially around the trees. Indeed, there are quite a few places in which roots from the trees have created hazards that could easily cause the children to trip. The upgrade has the support of the school fraternity as well as our own parish finance council.

The new playground will consist of more artificial turf under the sails to provide the little children with an improved surface for physical exercise.



There will also, around the artificial turf, be a concrete boarder that will be coloured with an oxide.

With the permission of Camden Council, two trees have been removed but will be replaced by two others that don't have the same aggressive root system. There would not have been much sense in laying new concrete which would be cracked within a few years. This project is being financed by contributions from the parents as well as funds raised by the P&F. Should look really good upon completion. (see pictures on the adjoining page)
