Parish Primary Schools

Over the school holidays a considerable amount of work was undertaken at our primary schools.

At St Clare's, an old basketball court has been resurfaced with synthetic grass laid across the top. This little project has been financed by the St Clare's P&F. Also, there was an old toilet block that was a part of the original buildings of 25 years ago. The work has redesigned and modernised the toilets to be much cleaner and safer. This project was financed from St Clare's SEDSO.

At St Paul's, parishioners may already have noticed how the old ash-felt has been peeled up and removed. The ground has been graded and concreting will come to completion this week. A sandstock-colour oxide was added for visual appeal. The project is being financed from St Paul's SEDSO. A large part of the concreting will then be covered by synthetic grass to establish another exercise area for the children. This part of the project is being financed by St Paul's P&F. Upon completion, this area is expected to add considerable practical and visual appeal to the site.
