Upcoming Feasts

Thursday 13 September ~ John Chrysostom (b. 349) After a brilliant course of studies, he began to lead a life of austerity and later ordained a priest. He became widely acclaimed as an outstanding preacher, becoming known as John of the Golden Mouth. He became Bishop of Constantinople and made considerable progress in reforming the morals of both clergy and people. He was undermined because of jealousy and twice sent into exile. He died from exhaustion.

Friday 14 September ~ **Exaltation of the Cross**. More noble, more precious than anything on earth, it is indeed a treasure, for in it and through it all the riches of our salvation were stored away and restored to us.

Saturday 15 September ~ Our Lady of Sorrows. Regarded as the Virgin Mary's spiritual martyrdom, this feast recalls how Mary stood by the cross and shared in her Son's passion. Jesus' side was pierced by a lance. Mary's souls was pierced by a sword of sorrow. This feast recalls that moment of the crucifixion in which between Jesus and Mary, love and sorrow are united totally and completely.

Magdalene Immersion Students

Year 11 students from Magdalene College are taking part this year in a newly formed programme entitled "Immersion". This wonderful initiative will sponsor the building of playgrounds for children with disabilities in the Belem (Bethlehem) Orphanage in Vietnam, which for a few years now has been supported by Father Joe and parishioners of Camden. A little painting will also be undertaken upon the interior of the buildings. The students will be travelling to the orphanage with Father Joe as chaplain. The tour group is not expected to require a local interpreter or translator.
