

Homily on the Feast of Annunciation (25 March 2020)

Meaning of 'FIAT' in this CORONA PERIOD

In these days of anxiety and uncertainty, what message can we share on this feast of the Annunciation of the Lord? Today we remember the good news of the birth of Jesus announced to Blessed Virgin Mary by the angel Gabriel.

Fulton J Sheen in his book '**Life of Christ**' says, "*Divinity is always where one least expects to find it*" (Life of Christ: page 27). It was mother Mary's humility and sincere heart that made her worthy to be the mother of the creator. She was excited to hear the unexpected and unbelievable news of the coming of the promised Messiah but also overwhelmed by the greetings and the important role she was to play. She had doubts of how it was all possible when she is a virgin, the society and other matters. In spite of all that, mother Mary decided to give the most challenging response in history which was – '**Fiat**' or Be it done.

Mother Mary's response, although simple, changed the direction of the history of mankind. She became the new Eve who saved us from Original Sin and helped us become the children of light once again, enjoying the true freedom and love of God the Father. Thus Mother Mary's humanity and willingness through the Holy Spirit resulted in the birth of the **Son of God** as the **Son of Man**.

Messages:

1) Let us be grateful to God for His love and Mercy:

As we are created in the image and likeness of God, and further we became his adopted children through Jesus Christ at the time of baptism. It is a pure gift from God that we got through the life, passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. So let us be humble enough to thank God for this great privilege and live like the children of God.

Something we never imagined is deliberate social isolation!

As the number of cases increase, familiar places and faces start becoming scary.

Can we say '**FIAT**' to the current situation?

Something impossible that we never wanted!

Here we need Mother Mary as our inspiration.

Her '**Fiat**' should enable us to go beyond the current situation.

We need to say "**YES**" for tomorrow, for others and for ourselves.

So we need to obey every rule and regulation for ourselves and most importantly for others, namely for our children and our local community and nation.
