## **Pastoral Reflection**

Over the past three years, the pastoral life of our parish – like so many others – has slowed a little.

However, Masses have been overwhelmingly well resourced with adult servers, accomplished readers, faithful wardens, reliable Ministers of the Eucharist, outstanding musicians + vocalists + choristers, cleaners, attendants to the altar linen, operators of our computerised projectors and faithful celebrants.

The full quota of six weekend Masses at The Oaks, Oakdale and Camden requires very considerable planning, rostering and resourcing. And the number of people involved is remarkably large and has, over the past few years, included generational change.

And now we're also recommencing our Penance Programme which also depends upon attendants to ensure everything proceeds with the precision of a Swiss watch.

Another wonderful ministry within our parish is the dedication to the sick and elderly, especially at Camden House and Carrington. Mass and prayer services with Holy Communion are scheduled in order to attend to the spiritual welfare of those no longer able to attend Holy Mass in our churches.

And home visitation from the clergy is always available upon request. So there's a big "upside' to the life of our parishes.

Pastoral initiatives, however, have been hampered with the pandemic and then from damage to the Heritage Hall. So future developments will continue to be modest over the next six months but can be expected to gather momentum after the repair and restoration of the HH. And by this time, the design of St Clare's church will be nearing completion.

In biblical imagery, we're now sowing seeds that, with the grace of Our Lord, will yield a plentiful harvest.
