Man arrested in the killing of Auxiliary Bishop

Most Reverend David G. O'Connell, a Roman Catholic bishop in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, was shot in his home in Hacienda Heights, California, on Saturday 18th February. The authorities said the man in custody was the husband of the bishop's housekeeper.

The suspect, Carlos Medina, 65, is married to Bishop O'Connell's housekeeper and had done work at the bishop's house.

A tipster told detectives on Sunday evening that he was concerned because Mr. Medina had been "acting strange, irrational and made comments about the bishop owing him money,"

Sheriff Luna said the motive remained under investigation. He said the housekeeper was fully cooperating with detectives.
