Confirmation ~ The Oaks and Camden

The Confirmation programme will begin with the distribution of the timeline on the weekend of 1st/2nd April at the Vigil and Sunday Masses. Children will need to have been baptised and made their first confession and in at least year 6 at school, before celebrating Confirmation. At this stage, there are anticipated to be:

- 3 ceremonies on Saturday 24th June at 12 Noon, 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM, and
- 2 Confirmation Masses on Sunday 25th PM at 10:00 PM and 12:30 PM.

However, if enrolment numbers are below 140, one of the ceremonies or Masses will be axed.

The time of each ceremony has been chosen to fit in with Bishop Brian's numerous administrative, pastoral and ceremonial commitments.

Saturday 1 April 2023 in St Aloysius Hall, The Oaks at 11:00 AM

The parish owns a large parcel of land -16 hectares - on the corner of Silverdale Road and Timothy Lacy Lane. It includes the St Aloysius Cemetery and is a short walk to the parish church.

The parcel of land comprises two different zones:

- The majority of land RU2 (15.19 hectares), and
- The cemetery SP2 plus an adjoining parcel also SP2 of about the same dimensions along Silverdale Road (0.81 hectare).

According to the Wollondilly Local Strategic Planning Statement

1. Objectives of RU2

- o To encourage sustainable primary industry production.
- o To maintain the rural landscape character of the land.
- o To support sustainable land management practices and local food production.

Permitted without consent: Extensive agriculture.

2. Objectives of SP2

- o To provide for infrastructure and related uses.
- o To prevent development that is not compatible with this infrastructure.

The land to be auctioned is the church land zoned RU2. The cemetery and the adjoining parcel that are both zoned SP2 will be retained by the parish.

All parishioners – who aren't otherwise being smashed by heavy loan repayments and rising costs – are asked to provide generous financial support to the parish. Personally, I contribute \$150/month.
