## The Oaks and Camden ~ Masses this week 25<sup>th</sup>/26<sup>th</sup>

Because of personal reasons, Father Victor is unable to be with us this weekend. So it's become a time of improvisation! Accordingly:

Father Richard Healey will be the celebrant at Oakdale on Saturday evening.

On Sunday morning, Father Michael will celebrate Masses at Camden at 8 AM, The Oaks at 9:00 AM and Camden at 10 AM. Then at 11:15 eight baptisms, then at 12:30 a family church ceremony for an old footie mate, then a luncheon, then Mass at 5:00 PM. The biggest problem is that the bulldogs are playing at 2:00 PM. Could be a quick luncheon.

Please note however, that at the 8:00 AM Mass and the 9:00 AM Mass, the homily will not be delivered during the normal time after the Gospel. Instead, it will be read by one of our parishioners after the final hymn. This will allow Father to make a quick getaway and absolutely avoid speeding.

## **Confirmations ~ The Oaks and Camden**

Reminder that the Confirmation programme for 2023 begins on the weekend of 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> April. The Timeline will be distributed, providing all the details on a 'week by week' basis. Parents/carers are required to be committed and motivated. Wonderful and sacred experience for the children and an enriching time for the families. The programme does pause for the school holidays, and recommences 22/23 April. Please don't enrol if holidays outside of the school break have been planned that clash with the weekly timetable. There's always next year.

Parents and carers are also advised that attendance records for the celebration of the sacraments are taken into account when offering places for Magdalene. Currently, there's an annual intake of about 210 children/teenagers into Year 7. In recent years, there's been well over 300 applications. So hard!
