Good Friday Appeal

And if we or our sons and daughters ever have the opportunity of visiting the Holy Land – possibly on a pilgrimage – it will be very apparent how important this appeal is through the universal church.

Contributions to this appeal are very much dedicated to the charitable works of the church. Charity is a very strong outward form and holiness. It is perfectly complimented by humility which is a very strong inward form of holiness. The virtue of humility was demonstrated so perfectly with the "Washing of the Feet".

Sacrament of Penance for Parishioners

Because of the very substantial number of people who had received absolution and forgiveness in the Sacrament of Penance on Wednesday this week, there is now a very real need to reintroduce the 2nd Rite of Reconciliation with visiting clergy leading into Easter and Christmas.

On Wednesday evening, both Father Victor and Father Michael were hearing confessions for almost two hours from 6:00 PM to 7.45 PM. And Father Victor had already dedicated another big chunk of time from 9:30 AM on the same day.

It's quite a healthy reflection upon our parishioners that so many are aware of the benefits in the reception of the Sacrament of Penance – benefits that include from Our Lord healing, mercy and compassion.

This sacrament – like Holy Communion – are very precious divine gifts from God. And if we have a long absence from these sacraments, then it's as if we're saying, "God I don't want your precious gifts; God you can keep your precious gifts to yourself".

The Eucharist sanctifies; Penance purifies.

Registration for the back-up programme begins on 22nd/23rd April. Before enrolment into the programme, children need to be able to recite the Our Father and the Hail Mary. These prayers are easy to learn if parents and children pray together for a few moments each day.
