The sacred ceremony is regarded as regional, meaning that it is intended for all parishes in the Macarthur. Our parishioners from The Oaks and Camden are warmly invited.

## ST CLARE'S CHURCH

Meeting details now confirmed for Thursday 25th May at 6:00 PM in St Clare's School Library.

The architect will be providing a presentation, and questions will be welcomed afterwards.

The floor plan is largely completed but there are still other outstanding matters concerning how the church is to be adorned, as well as the colour blends.

The church is not intended to be overly large. Within the main body of the church, the capacity is planned for about 400 adults which – with two Sunday Masses – will comfortably accommodate prevailing demand.

As a point of reference, Camden holds 550 adults which translates into many more when considering school children.

The St Clare's church has been designed to be contemporary in style and intended to reflect architectural thinking of the 2020s. But there is one big gamble – that being the size of the narthex (bit like the foyer).

Traditionally, the narthex has been a small dark passageway into a large church. But the narthex for St Clare's has the dimensions of a small-to-medium school classroom to serve a variety of purposes.

Historically, back at the old Smeaton Grange Mass Centre which served this part of the parish for 25 years from 1984 to 2009, there had always been a serious emphasis on hospitality. For a long stretch spanning many years the gentle old friar, Fr Alan Hartcher, encouraged people to remain after Mass for 'coffee and cake'. The new church will try to once again embrace this lovely custom to foster community and fraternity.

All parishioners from Camden and The Oaks are invited to attend the meeting this Thursday for - what promises to be - a very interesting presentation.

## **Confirmation Programme**

Fighting with others Harmful words and actions


Disregard to home duties Selfishness
