# MASSES AT CAMDEN THIS WEEKEND

Parishioners may remember from earlier in the year, a decision was taken to restore a chalice and an asperges bowl. Both were looking quite awful as if having been exposed to the outdoor elements for far too long.

So a quote was obtained for restoration which came in at 2,000 bikkies for the stirling-silver chalice and about 1,000 bikkies for the bowl. The final outcome from the restoration process exceeded expectations and was quite outstanding.

And to make a good story even better, one of our parishioners donated \$2,000 and another pairshioner donated \$1,000.

Both the chalice and the asperges bowl will be either used or on display this weekend at all Masses including the Confirmation ceremonies.
