## FATHER ALLAN HARTCHER OFM RIP

Father Allan's Requiem Mass was offered a few days ago on Wednesday 12 July at St Francis of Assisi Paddington. When a person has reached the venerable age of 90, funerals are generally not so large because the deceased has long since retired and outlived most of his/her contemporaries. But there were more than a dozen friars who were among the congregation along with about 15 of Father Allan's dear friends from our own parish, and other parishes nearby.

In keeping with Father Allan's wishes, Mass included beautifully sacred and traditional church music that was provided by about 20 accomplished choristers and a very fine organist.

Those who were present will long remember the sacred and solemn celebration of the Mass, the beautiful words from the celebrant as well as one very lengthy eulogy.

#### FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME

The FHC will begin on the first weekend in September. As advised previously, the programme will include a Prayer Assessment Evening in September in which children will be asked to recite the Our Father, Hail Mary and Act of Contrition. In addition – and by mid-November – the children will also be expected to be able to recite the Glory Be.

Within the programme, a new component will be added. It will be called 'Rosay Night'. A few opportunities will be available and the duration of the evening will be from 6:00 PM to 6:30 PM.

Each candidate for FHC will need to be present along with a parent/carer/elder sibling. Both should have a set of rosary beads, possibly borrowed so as to leave the option of rosary beads as a gift for FHC. Other family members may also come along. Please, no negativity. The occasion will be most enriching.

The evening is expected to include two Marian hymns – one at the beginning and one at the end. So in preparation, parents/carers and children might like to begin familiarising themselves with the first of the two hymns:
