Our programme continues to develop with special emphasis on weekly presence at Mass, midweek reading and discussion in groups. This will be the final opportunity to be part of this year's programme.

### ST CLARE'S CHURCH

Following the most recent community meeting in which there was most helpful discussion, it soon became apparent that there needed to be a slight realignment of boundaries to ensure ongoing vehicle access to the present cemetery and also to the eventual extension of the present cemetery. Hearses as well as vehicles for stonemasonry and maintenance will forever involve proper access. Matters are now being managed by the legal fraternity to ensure a smooth outcome.

# ST PAUL'S HERITAGE HALL

There has been progress in recent weeks. And it now appears highly likely that the problem which led to the seepage of water beneath the floorboards has only recently been rectified. Plans are now underway for a new floor to replace the old floor. And that will be followed by fresh carpeting and other ancillary works. Hopefully the hall will be back to its heritage best well before the end of the year.
