PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

ST CLARE'S CHURCH

During August, the plans and drawings for the church were submitted to Camden Council for a preliminary meeting before the formal submission of a DA (Development Application). Practical matters such as traffic flow came under consideration with accompanying requirements.

The urban design was also reviewed and included references to landscaping, building materials, colours, and imagery within the stained glass. It was noted, in particular, that "the use of blank walls should be limited and offset with landscaping elements of a complimentary height.

In summary, it appears that the design of the church is moving in the right direction although more work is still to be done.

Further reports will be provided in coming weeks. And thanks to the parishioners who participated in the survey that was open to all. Feedback was really valued.

Hearses as well as vehicles for stonemasonry and maintenance will forever require proper access. Matters are now being managed by the legal fraternity to ensure a smooth outcome.
