NOVEMBER MASS INTENTIONS

Specially designated envelopes will be available from next weekend but other standard envelopes are still ok. All Masses in our two parishes during November will be offered for the deceased family members and friends of parishioners at Camden and The Oaks. Please write name(s) of the deceased on an envelope and drop in the collection bag. Following a decision from the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference quite a few years ago, the minimum offering is \$20. However, in cases of genuine financial hardship, smaller amounts are ok.

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL (PPC)

Now in the process of finalising membership to the PPC. One more meeting is planned for the end of the year. January 2024 begins a new three-year term until the end of 2026. The PPC meets every two months or more often if required.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME

This week families need to complete every question/puzzle or drawing from pages 18 to 25. Assistance sheets for workshop three will be distributed at all Masses.

Forms for the First Holy Communion ceremony preferences will also be distributed, these forms need to be filled in and handed back to the attendants. DO NOT TAKE HOME. Ceremony allocation is completed by Monday morning so forms not handed in at Mass this weekend will not be able to be included in the first selection. Numbers at each ceremony are set and every effort is made to accommodate family requirements, but obviously not every family will be able to receive their first choice. Please mark forms with at least 3 choices. If your family has SPECIAL circumstances a short note explaining these will assist in the allocating. Forms with one choice only cannot be accepted.

A leaflet with ceremony allocations will be distributed at all Masses 28/29 October. Advance knowledge of allocations is not available to calls and emails to the parish office. Families who have not submitted their preferences will be asked to complete a renewed form on that weekend showing ceremonies with spaces still available.
