21 January, Feast of St Agnes, Virgin and Martyr

At the age of 13, Agnes had become a beautiful young teenager who committed her life to Christ. She resisted the advances of local noblemen who wanted her hand in marriage. She was accused of being a Christian – of which she proudly acknowledged – at a time when the church was under serious persecution in the early fourth century. It was said by St Ambrose that Agnes went to her execution more cheerfully than others go to their wedding.

PENANCE PROGRAMME FOR CHILDREN

The programme recommences next weekend the 27/28 January. Please be mindful that the 'Prayer Assessment Evening' has been scheduled for one month's time, Tuesday 27th and Wednesday 28th February. Children need to be able to recite their prayers to have reached a readiness for their first confession.

The practical reason why a knowledge of prayer is so necessary is because the Sacrament of Penance includes - after the confession by the penitent – an issuing of penance which usually includes the recitation of prayers. Parents, therefore, are asked to start teaching their children the Our Father, Hail Mary and the Act of Contrition. Prayer Cards to assist families will be distributed at all Masses next weekend.

Of course, a deeper reason why children need to know their prayers is so that they can pray. St Mother Theresa of Calcutta was once asked by a person how to pray. She responded: "Say the Our Father, but take an hour to say it"
