# Dear Parishioners at Camden and The Oaks

# 5<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME ~ 4<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2024

St Paul Miki and His Companions, **Martyrs**Feast Day 6 February

Born in Japan between the years 1564 and 1566. Paul entered the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) and preached the Gospel with success, but when a persecution of Catholics arose, he and twenty-five others were seized and subjected to terrible tortures, and finally were crucified at Nagasaki in the year 1597 on 5 February. He dying remarks were:

"The only reason for my being killed, is that I have taught the doctrine of Christ. I thank God it is for this reason that I die. I believe that I am telling the truth before I die. I know you believe me and I want to say to you all once again – ask Christ to help you become happy. I obey Christ. After Christ's example, I forgive my persecutors. I do not hate them. I ask God to have pity on all and I hope my blood will fall on my fellow men as a fruitful rain."

#### FATHER VICTOR

After a term of almost three years, this Sunday with the 5:00 PM Mass will bring to conclusion Father Victor's appointment in the parish of Camden.

However, there will be a transition period of about 10 days before Father takes up his priestly duties at Vincentia. During this time, Father has very helpfully agreed to celebrate Mass at Oakdale on 10 February and The Oaks on 11 February at the normal times.

In his own humble way, Father Victor declined an offer for a large farewell but was present for a quiet morning tea on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February after the 9:00 AM Mass. And it was at this time, that a presentation was made.
