FATHER JAMES ARBLASTER ~ ARRIVING 15 FEBRUARY 2024

Fr James grew up in Albion Park Rail as the eldest of three boys. While going to school at St Paul's Primary and St Joseph's High School, both in Albion Park, he attended World Youth Day 2008 in Sydney as a Year 12 student, which was pivotal for his faith journey.

That year, he first felt the call to the priesthood, but ignored it. He went on to study Law and International Studies at the University of Wollongong, during which time he also spent a year as an international student in Leon, Spain.

Upon returning to Australia, Fr James wrestled with his faith until he finished university, when he decided to enter the seminary to further explore the call to priestly ministry. After much discernment, James realised the call to the priesthood was the best path for his life and the best thing he could do for others and personally committed his life to God.

After seven years in formation, Bishop Mascord ordained James to the priesthood on 10 Dec 2022. Fr James has been ministering in the cathedral parish and the university chaplaincy in Wollongong but will take up his new appointment as assistant priest in Camden parish effective the First Sunday of Lent 2024. As Father James will be in residence from the 15th of February, he has also agreed to assist with morning Masses on Friday 16th and Saturday 17th at 9.00am.

BTW: For those who have been in this world for over six decades, the memory might stretch back far enough to recall the introduction of decimal currency on the 14 February 1966.

Previously, legal tender in Australia was in pounds, shilling and pence. It was a very difficult currency. The change to decimal currency was an enormous step forward for the economy, and for the retail sector especially.

Season of Lent

The season of Lent is period of fasting and regret for one's sins that is observed on the 40 days from Ash Wednesday up until – but not including – the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday Evening.

<u>Prayer</u>, <u>fasting</u> and <u>almsgiving</u> should in various ways be embraced during the season of Lent by the *Christifideles* (Christ's faithful).

Meat should not be eaten on Ash Wednesday and, in the spirit of fasting, gourmet foods like prawns, oysters and lobsters should also be avoided. Keep it simple!

So before Ash Wednesday, there is a responsibility upon the *Christifideles* to consider possible sacrifices that require some effort but still manageable.

Lenten Group and Resources

For those who are interested, there is a Lenten group on the Thursday mornings during Lent after the 9:00 AM Mass. Please, for a few dollars, buy a copy of the diocesan Lenten publication entitled, *Pieta*.

Even if not joining the Lenten group, this publication is a valuable resource for prayer at home. The cost of the booklet is just \$4.50.

If wanting a booklet but unable to afford because of rising cost pressures upon the family budget, please feel free to take a complimentary copy.

In our own parishes of Camden and The Oaks, affordability will never be a barrier to parishioners having possession of the spiritual reading and publications that are produced by our own diocese.
