Come See, Go Make

For a few months, the opportunity has been available to all our parishioners at Camden and The Oaks to take home a copy of the Bishop's pastoral plan entitled, 'Come See, Go Make'. The entire pastoral plan has been presented in the form of three separate booklets.

About 10 days ago, the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) began to look at these booklets but it's not the kind of reading that can be covered thoughtfully in an hour or two. Accordingly, this pastoral plan will be a permanent agenda item for the PPC for at least 2024.

A follow-up booklet has now also become available, containing many pages of worksheet activities. These booklets will be situation on the various magazine tables around our churches. Please collect one as many boxes full of booklets have arrived.

The author(s) explain on the inside front cover that working through these booklets is best undertaken as a parish community in a large group over a number of sessions with more than 50 people. Alternatively, it might also be possible to facilitate smaller groups ranging from 8-12 people.

Further developments, initiatives and invitations will be announced in coming weeks and months.

Penance Programme for Children

Few Messages:

Workbooks need to be handed to the attendants this weekend after Masses for review. They will be returned the following weekend with a parish stamp if all the work has been of a satisfactory standard. Parents are requested to look through the books prior to handing in to ensure that the children have completed every question/puzzle, as this will save the books being returned for re-working.

Families who did not attend the 'Prayer Assessment Evening' last week will not be able to move onto the next stage of the programme. However, preparation can be recommenced mid-year in 2024 when enrolment into a back-up programme will be available.

Alternatively, Father Michael will be in the chapel at Camden this Saturday morning from 10:30 AM to 11:00 AM if any of these families want to continue in the existing programme.

Please keep in mind that completion of the Penance Programme is absolutely necessary for enrolment into the First Holy Communion programme which begins from the first weekend in September. It a legal requirement in church law.
