About Easter Sunday

All of us, when we let ourselves be mastered by sin, lose the right way and end up straying like lost sheep.

But God himself, our shepherd, has come in search of us. To save us, he lowered himself even to accepting death on the cross.

On Easter Sunday especially, and during the Easter season, the Church proclaims that the Good Shepherd who laid down his life for his sheep and who willingly died for his flock has risen from the dead so that we may have new life.

Parish Pastoral Council

Catholic Schools

The three systemic schools in our parish – St Paul's, St Clare's and Magdalene – have received an enormous number of applications for enrolment next year, far more than the number of places available. Huge demand.

It's not too hard to understand the intense interest. Teachers and ancillary personnel work with serious commitment to providing intellectual, physical and spiritual formation for all the children and teenagers in a pastoral setting where all students are respected. Very good learning and fraternal environment at all three schools.

The liturgies at St Clare's and St Paul's before and after Easter were exceptionally good. Children were enriched by the ceremonies and were able to participate in prayer and in sacred music. And the standard of behaviour could best be described as excellent. Wonderful work by our schools.

The situation at Mater Dei is seriously different from our systemic schools. Children and teenagers have special challenges and require teachers and ancillary personal who, themselves, have a high level of personal development.

Mater Dei school – Mother of God – is among the most important schools in our nation. And the teachers do a remarkable job in preparing students for the sacred ceremonies.

We pray that under the patronage of Mary, the school will continue to be able to devote the necessary resources to all the students who have a such a wide variety of different needs. God bless Mater Dei.

Confirmation Programme

Almost 160 families have registered so far. Enrolment forms to be distributed this weekend. If away from Mass in our parishes at The Oaks and Camden last weekend, it's still possible to enrol and to also collect the programme timeline. At this stage, it's anticipated that only four Masses/ceremonies will be required. If there's a late rush this week, and enrolments climb towards 200, then five Masses/ceremonies will be available.

The baskets for deposit will be at all weekend Masses for a few more weeks.
