- In keeping with a recommendation from the Parish Finance Council, the PPC also recommended financing for the installation of solar panels on the presbytery roof depending upon a favourable assessment of the strength of the 38-year-old roof.
- Seek professional advice concerning the cost and upgrade of the sound system in the church
- After the success of the 'Pentecost Event' in the HH, to definitely organise an Advent Event later in the year. Discussion topics always interesting and engaging.
