After participating in a programme that began on the First Weekend of Advent in 2024, just under 180 children celebrated their first confession over the past week. The programme contained the following essential components:

- ✓ Examination of Consciences.

Among the parts of the programme, the attendance at Mass in the presence of our worshipping community is an irreplaceable foundation.

It is within our gathered assembly that children come into the presence of priests and devoted parishioners, as well as having an enriching and life-giving experience of Word and Sacrament. And the sacred music – as a form of praise – assists invaluably in raising our hearts and minds towards our loving God.

All considered, the Penance Programme administered over 2024/25 can be regarded as remarkably successful. The overwhelming number of parents – and with the fewest of exceptions – have contributed with a very high level of commitment, humility and trust.

Confirmation Programme 2025
