# Palm Sunday ~ Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2025

Palm Sunday is the Sunday before Easter. It marks the beginning of Holy Week and commemorates Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. It is a time of joyful celebration and the final Sunday of Lent, when we complete our obligations of Penance, Fasting and Almsgiving. It marks the beginning of Jesus' final journey which ends with His arrest on Holy Thursday and crucifixion on Good Friday.

For our Palms for Palm Sunday, Easter Vigil candles, for the Holy water vials, this year the cleaning of the church, and the preparation of the church for the many ceremonies that are a part of Easter, it takes many, many hands. Our thanks are extended to everyone who has contributed.

To our families who chop and deliver their Palm fronds. To Michelle Roffe Funerals who supplies the funds for us to purchase the beautiful Easter candles for Saint Paul's Camden, Saint Joseph the Worker Oakdale and Saint Aloysius The Oaks. These candles will be lit throughout the Easter season, then at every Baptism and Funeral during the coming year. To Camden Pharmacy Focus who supply the vials for our Holy water, our gratitude is extended.

Parishioners are asked to be aware of the work involved in all this preparation and we ask that all consider others when taking advantage of the supply of candles, water and palms.

# **Easter Vigil Candles**

The Parish has again purchased 300 individual candles which will be on sale before the Easter Vigil Mass. These candles enable parishioners to be part of the special blessing of the fire and the procession into the darkened church. Each candle will cost \$2.00, and all funds raised will be added to the Holy Land Collections that take place on Good Friday. The Holy sites need our assistance particularly at this troubled time.

## Parish Event ~ Saturday 31 May

Our next Parish Event is scheduled for the 31 May, in our Heritage Hall. Numbers are capped at 90 as this is the number that can be comfortably seated in the Hall. Cost for the two course meal and refreshments is \$20.00. Please contact the Parish Office during normal hours to book your place and avoid disappointment.

#### **Confirmation Programme 2025**

Families will be invited to submit their child's name for our Sacrament of Confirmation programme at all Masses over the weekend of 26/27 April. Names will be taken and timelines distributed. Children must be in year 6 or higher and completed their Sacraments of Penance and First Holy Communion. Further information will be made available over the next few weeks through our Weekly Message.

Next Thursday, Holy Thursday 17 April, the Parish Office will be closing at 1.00pm to allow our secretaries to be part of the Easter Triduum. Normal hours will resume on Tuesday 22 April. Parishioners are asked to contact the office early in the week if they need any assistance.
