# **Sacrament of Penance Programme**

Registrations for Mass are essential. On-line bookings can be made through the parish website, or by phoning the parish office during business hours: Tuesday – Thursday 9:00~AM-4:00~PM, Friday 9:00~AM-1:00~PM.

When children were enrolled at the end of November and into December, a decision had still to be made about the kind of preparation that would apply for the programme – either preparation in groups or preparation among family members at home.

That decision has now been taken. The preparation will now need to be undertaken at home. So at Masses this weekend, there will be no need to indicate preferences for workshops, but parents/carers are asked to collect a form afterwards and complete before leaving the church. This should only take a few moments and will assist in administering the programme which needs to be "family-friendly".

Books will be distributed on the weekend of 6/7 February. The following two weeks are intense. Parents/carers will need to be motivated. About two hours in each of these two weeks will be necessary for assisting the children to complete the assigned activity pages which over the following seven days will span from page 3 to page 15, inclusive.

The most difficult part of the programme is when, in instances of unsatisfactorily completed books, I need to ring to advise the parents that they cannot continue in the programme this year. That was the unfortunate experience for some parents in last year's First Holy Communion Programme. Never pleasant but occasionally unavoidable.

#### **Bushfires**

This time last year the bushfires in various parts of NSW were raging like an inferno from hell. Smoke blanketed so many parts of the state causing serious concerns about air pollution. At times it was all quite suffocating. There were numerous reports about widespread destruction of homes, properties, businesses and our natural environment.
