The only difficulty, so far, is the heavy concentration of people who arrive at Camden just as Mass is about to start. There were instances last week where the queues were noticeably lengthy.

Could be a good idea to try arriving at Mass about five minutes earlier. The experience of then slowing down and sitting quietly in church for a few moments can be rather calming. A few minutes without verbiage can also help to discern the presence of God in our lives.

'Definitely worth a try. And it won't cost anything, and nor will it cause any suffering. Silence, stillness, solitude!

Much better to be experiencing silence, stillness, and solitude rather than sin, suffering and sickness. (and that's too true)!

Books to be distributed this weekend with a slip of paper that contains some of the answers for the first workshop. Good time to take an exceptionally close interest in the spiritual formation of children, especially in their knowledge of prayers.

Children should be able to recite the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be. Before the end of the programme, it will also be necessary to be able to recite the Act of Contrition (parents/carers and children).

Personalised books will be distributed this week along with a slip of paper that contains some of the answers for the first workshop. Enquiries can be directed to one of the priests or attendants after Mass.

Reminder that families will have the opportunity to select their preferred time for Ceremony/Mass on the weekend of 22/23 May. Interim leaflets will be distributed the following weekend on 29/30 June that list the Ceremonies/Masses to which candidates have been assigned.

However, an official final leaflet will be distributed on 12/13 June that may (or may not) be the same as the interim leaflet according to whether the books have been satisfactorily completed.

Up until now every measure has been taken to assist families towards having an enriching experience of the programme. So from this weekend, the programme moves up a gear. It becomes the turn of parents/carers and their children to invest time and dedication to carefully completing the activity pages at home.

In terms of one cliché (possibly tedious) "parents and carers need to catch the ball and run with it".

Also, it's not too soon to start thinking about sponsors and names for saints. This needs to involve discernment and a discussion among family members.

There were almost 1,200 people at Mass last week in Camden. Because of social distancing requirements, there were not so many at Oakdale and The Oaks where there remained plenty of room at both churches for those who value Sunday Mass.

'Thought this extract could be interesting:

During the Covid-19 pandemic, the faithful have been able to switch between TV channels in search of televised Masses that suite their time and taste. The data provided by Google Analytics for the parish of Greystanes in the Diocese of Parramatta indicate that during live-streamed Mass, most viewers stay for an average of two minutes during the homily before moving to other TV preachers. It is not the boring homily causing the tap on the remote control. Rather, many Mass viewers are not regulars and hence are alien to the priests and parish community.
