Coronavirus Restrictions

No Masses this weekend. Hoping for some kind of return to our normal covid schedule after Friday 9 July. In all likelihood, all three churches will be limited to 1:4 (1 person per four square metres). Accordingly:

- 1. The change in social distancing means far less people can be present at Mass at the one time.
- 2. No congregational singing.
- 3. Masks need to be worn.

If Masses are celebrated from next weekend, please remember that if receiving Holy Communion, then momentarily remove or partially remove the mask before receiving the host. Then consume the host with reverence and refit the mask. With thanks

#### **Confirmation Celebration**

Well the families in the Confirmation programme have had plenty of luck over the past few weeks but most of it was bad.

In the week leading up to the celebrations – because of the reinstatement of the Coronavirus restrictions – it became necessary to reduce the number people attending from 7/family to 4/family. Many thanks to the overwhelming number of families for being so understanding.

Then word quickly spread on early Saturday afternoon that there would be a complete lockdown from 6:00 PM Saturday. So the three Saturday ceremonies were celebrated quite beautifully but the two Sunday ceremonies were cancelled.

Bishop Brian has generously agreed to return to celebrate the remaining two ceremonies on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> July at 10 AM (for last Sundays 10:30 AM families) and 12 Noon (for last Sundays 1:00 PM families). There will be brief rehearsals on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July at 5:00 PM and then 5:30 PM to freshen up on the responses. Seating allocation will remain the same.

The ceremonies are, of course, dependent upon the lockdown situation. If the church is limited to 100 people – as is now the case with funerals – then it will only be possible to have three per family, including candidate and sponsor. However, under such a scenario, the parish will pay for the livestreaming of both ceremonies.

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 3rd/4th July 2021

All ceremonies in the church this weekend are cancelled. This is a decision taken by the NSW Premier. Please refrain from abusing clergy and parish secretaries who are doing their very best to best serve all our parishioners under constantly changing circuimstances.

There is a Mass on Channel 10 on Sunday mornings.

There's a parish in the USA where – during a protracted period of lockdown – parishioners were able to watch their parish Mass being celebrated by the PP alone. It was live streamed on a Sunday morning and included a homily. After Mass, the parishioners were invited to visit the parish site briefly where Holy Communion would be distributed outdoors on the hand for those who had watched Mass.

This option will be considered if the lockdown continues.

If introduced, fasting applies. Not appropriate to indulge on an over-size breakfast while watching Mass and then arrive at the parish site 20 minutes later with a full belly to receive Holy Communion.

Not suggesting that our parishioners would do this; just being cautious.
