15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Unfortunately, with the continuation of the lockdown, it is still not possible to celebrate Masses this weekend or midweek Masses up until and including the 16 July.

Spiritual Insight

From Father Michael White and lay associate Tom Corcoran who co-authored a book entitled 'Rebuilt' about a Catholic parish in America that was in decline but reformed to become a truly faith-filled community.

Greed, or avarice, is the love of money and wealth in an inappropriate or even destructive way. It comes in different forms so we must be on guard to recognise it. In Catholic moral theology it is treated as a serious vice because it raises money to the purpose of life itself.

If greed was a problem in a poor agrarian community two thousand years ago, it must be exponentially more so in our contemporary consumer culture. Billions of dollars are spent each year on advertising and marketing; new technologies, styles, flavours, models and brands hit the stores daily. And every day our culture reminds us of what we don't have, encouraging us to believe that if we had it, we'd be happy. We buy the lie and spend like no others in human history (p. 172).

Coronavirus Restrictions

From this Tuesday 13 July, it will be possible to make bookings for the following weekend 17/18 July in anticipation of the end of the lockdown on Friday 16th. But there's no guarantee that the lockdown will be brought to an end. Developments will be reported as they come to hand.

In all likelihood, all three churches will be limited to 1:4 (1 person per four square metres). Accordingly:

- 1. The change in social distancing means far less people can be present at Mass at the one time.
- 2. No congregational singing.
- 3. Masks need to be worn.

If Masses are able to be celebrated from the weekend of 17/18 July, please remember that if receiving Holy Communion, then momentarily remove or partially remove the mask before receiving the host. Then consume the host with reverence and refit the mask. With thanks
