Our Community Pantry

Our Community Pantry (OCP) is a Food-Rescue Service that diverts perfectly good food that would otherwise be heading to landfill, and make it available, and affordable, to its members across the Camden, Campbelltown, Wollondilly, Wingecarribee and Goulburn LGA's. Our guiding principles are Fill Plates, Not Landfills Hand-up, Not Hand-Out Our Hamper Range includes the Family Hamper, Seniors/Singles Hamper and our Staples Hamper. Other Household Essential Packs and Meat Packs are also available.

\$60 FAMILY HAMPER

(items equate to over \$250 value in-store)

- Designed for families, based upon a weekly basis
- Includes three Family Meal Meat options, pantry staples, school snacks, household items, chiller bag including dairy items
- Fruit, vegetables, bread and bakery items

\$50 SENIORS/SINGLES HAMPER

- Designed for seniors or single, based upon a fortnightly basis
- Includes three Smaller Meal Meat options, pantry staples snacks, household items, chiller bag including dairy items
- Fruit, vegetables, bread and bakery items

\$25 STAPLES HAMPER

- Designed to supplement with three basic staple items
- Fruit, vegetables, bread and bakery items

Any donations are accepted, anything from food, blankets, gift cards, etc.

OCP do the hamper collections – drive through system contactless at the C3 church Mount Annan grounds on Wednesday evening between 6.00 -7.00pm. this is the only one in our local LGA. They also do Campbelltown on Thursday evenings, but would require a letter from OCP that they are an essential volunteer.
