Pastoral Reflection from Pope Francis

The "scourge" of the pandemic, the pope said, "has tested everyone and everything. Only one thing is more serious than this crisis, and that is the risk that we will squander it, and not learn the lesson it teaches. It is a lesson in humility, showing us that it is not possible to live healthy lives in an unhealthy world, or to go on as we were, without recognizing what went wrong."

Francis also warned against the "senseless notion" that the world can go back to what it was, relying on "false securities, habits and projects that aim exclusively at pursuing wealth and personal interests, while failing to respond to global injustice, the cry of the poor and the precarious health of our planet."
