#### **Roadmap for our Parishes ~ October/November**

In keeping with NSW Public Health Orders (PHO) and procedures formulated by the Diocese of Wollongong, the Vigil and Sunday Masses will recommence in our own parishes on the last weekend of October. According to projections by NSW Health, Stage 2 will officially begin on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> October when it's expected that 80% of people 16 and over in NSW will be fully vaccinated.

From the final weekend in October and during November (Stage 2), a maximum of 140 people will be allowed in Mass at Camden, with 16 at The Oaks and 36 at Oakdale.

Baptisms will be celebrated every Sunday at Camden with a maximum of 6 infants/children and 20 people per family.

Funerals will be conducted and may have 100 people in attendance. However, if an unvaccinated person wishes to attend, a maximum of only 10 people are permitted in the church.

Weddings will be celebrated and may have 100 people in attendance. However, if an unvaccinated person wishes to attend, a maximum of only 5 people are permitted in the church.

Comment: Could be a very good idea to be fully vaccinated.
